Biography

Jon Sass is well known as a true Groove Master and to be arguably one of the most creative tuba players today! His



imitable approach and soulful sound on the tuba have led him to a truly unique career. Born in New York City, Jon grew up in Harlem and started playing tuba at 14. Playing Professional playing happened very early. Four years after he started playing, he literally found himself in university while simultaneously commuting between Boston, Vienna, and New York at the age of 18.

With choices on his horizon, Jon chose to move to Vienna after graduating from Boston University. Offers came soon after he arrived. Throughout that time he has played, recorded, and toured worldwide with the crème de la crème of musicians and featured together with artists such as Ivan Neville, Vince Mendoza, Peter Wolf, Ricky Ford, Bobby Shew, Steven Mead, chamber ensembles of the Vienna and Berlin Philharmonic, in duo with Dave Taylor, Hazmat Modine, Doug Hammond, Arkady Shilkloper, Wolfgang Puschnig, and Millagros Pin Era. Other artists include Ray Anderson, Michelle Rosewoman, David Murray, Sunny Murray, Butch Morris, James Spaulding, Leon Thomas, Peter Erskine, Frank Foster, Erika Stucky, Henry Threadgill, Hans Theessink, Linda Tillery and the Heritage Cultural Choir, Howard Johnson Heavy Tuba, and Vienna Art Orchestra.

As a solo artist, he's featured with Major European Big-bands to Vienna Chamber Orchestra, Symphonic Wind Ensembles as well as many feature events. Jon composes his own music and has arranged music for the James Brown Horns. He can be heard on over 100 recordings. After years of playing as frontman or ensemble member, re-evaluating the picture of his life as a musician took a turning point. A creative process began around that time reflecting a hunger for self-expression and satisfy the inner-child. Exactly that, was the result of his first solo CD SASSIFIED, which was "my own therapy to satisfy my soul, intended to be shared with others". This CD received great response and is considered a milestone for the genre of brass playing.

Although rare for a tuba player, Jon creates his own music and performance concepts such as the multi-media programs "Sassified-Live" and "Sassy the Tuba". He also developed a basis for progressive creative thinking called Creative Impulse which has inspired the creation of play-along books from Editions BIM and TMV records, and for team-building seminars- such as Corporate Groove.

Jon's worldview is that "all things in our universe are connected, and music has the power to heal, create positive emotions, bring different people together and provide enlightenment!"
